Dear Parents/Carers of Marine Academy Primary **Year 2** pupils,

This term, Year 2 will be learning about '**Our Food, Our World**' in their **Geography** lessons. This topic links the everyday experience of buying and eating food within the UK, along with the children's growing geographical understanding of the world. Children study the local area, looking closely at a market and farm to understand the connections between what we buy, where it comes from locally and how it might be able to be sourced from the UK (and beyond).



A knowledge organiser, sharing all of the information that the children will learn about in their Geography lessons, is attached. Please feel free to use this with your child at home.

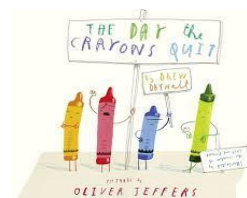


In **Science**, the children will be learning about what it takes to be a master chef! They will classify utensils and food, learn about the basic needs of humans for survival and the importance of a healthy diet.

In **English**, the children's writing will be based on the books 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Christopher Corr and Stephen Davies and 'This is How We Do It'

by Matt Lamothe. In their **Whole Class**

Reading sessions, they will be studying 'Cereal Superfan' by Julia Donaldson.



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In **Maths**, the children will be learning how to: tell and write the time to 5 minute intervals, including half past and quarter to/past. Also, they will practise using combinations of money and develop their place value skills, including completing missing number calculations.

In **RE**, the children will explore the question, 'What does it mean to belong to a faith community?', while in **SMSC** (Spiritual, Moral, Social and Cultural education), the children will learn about 'Growing and Changing'.

In **Music**, they will learn to understand that rhythm has value and melody is important in music and in **Design Technology**, they will be creating a healthy and nutritious vegetable wrap.



PE will be tennis and it will take place on Fridays - children should wear their PE kit to school on this day please.
